


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

Once the first coat is dry, apply a top coat of desired colour and surface texture to completely embed CoverCrakZ in the paint layer and cover the fibre pattern.

- To ensure your first drop of Cover-CrakZ is straight, use a plumb-line.
- Trim Cover-CrakZ with a cutting knife and straight edge rather than using scissors.
- Smooth joins will be achieved if the drops are butted edge to edge, rather than overlapped. To line up the vertical edges, leave a 50mm unpainted strip of the last drop of Cover-CrakZ, to which the next drop can be butted to. This is easier than trying to line up a wet edge and a dry edge. Then paint over the edges to join the drops.
- If overlapping occurs, sand off the top layer once the first coat of paint has dried to create a smooth join.
- ✓ If a crease appears, stop painting, quickly lift Cover-CrakZ and readjust the fibre.
- Smooth out small creases by working the paint roller in opposing diagonal directions.
- When applying CoverCrakZ into a corner, use a paint brush with a stippling action. When applying around a corner, ease Cover-CrakZ onto the new surface using the paint roller in a horizontal motion.

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
